APPRENTICESHIPS AND ADVANCED APPRENTICESHIPS IN BRICKLAYING

Increased activity in the building industry has seen an increased demand for skilled bricklayers. Apprenticeships provide the opportunity to meet this demand. The key elements of the course include the following modules.

1. NVQ LEVEL 2 UNITS mandatory core units

- Conform to general workplace safety.
- Conform to efficient work practices.
- Moving and handling resources.
- Erect masonry structures.
- Set-out masonry structures.
- Place and Finish Concrete

2. NVQ LEVEL 3 UNITS mandatory core units

- VR 01 Conform to general workplace safety.
- VR 209 Confirm work activities and resources for the work.
- VR 210 Develop and maintain good working relationships.
- VR 211 Confirm the occupational method of work.
- VR 48 Set out complex masonry structures.
- VR 49 Erect complex masonry structures.

3. FUNCTIONAL SKILLS

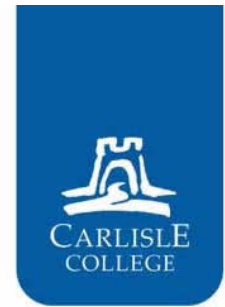
The functional skills contained within the framework for Bricklaying Apprenticeships include

5. TECHNICAL CERTIFICATE

Each apprentice will follow a vocationally related qualification which focuses on the underpinning knowledge and understanding of the skills required.

6. HEALTH AND SAFETY TEST

All apprentices must pass a Health Safety test as part of both the apprentices and advanced apprenticeship courses.

7. ABRASIVE WHEELS CERTIFICATE

Each apprentice is trained and tested on the safe working of abrasive wheel equipment.
